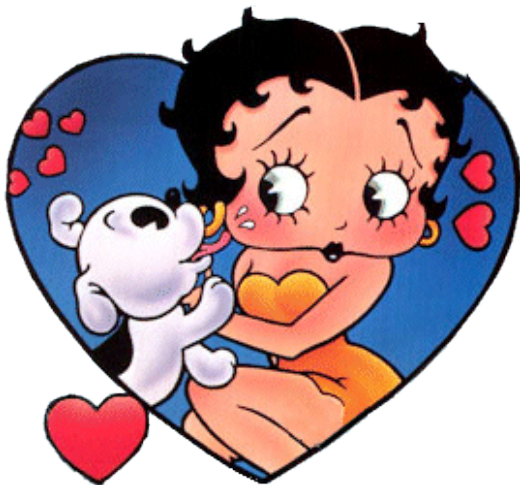

## QUOTATION EXAMPLE:



*Curley's Wife's body language is deliberately provocative when she leans "so that her body was thrown forward," (18) revealing, through this suggestive posture, her need to be noticed and admired by men.*

**E:** ..."so that her body was thrown forward," (18)...

**A:** ...revealing, through this suggestive posture, her need to be noticed and admired by men.
